#### #1 Unlimited

Most all competitive Rimfire Benchrest shooters know what this means. One-piece rests, full custom rifles, and the like. No restrictions.

#### #2 Factory Class

Any factory-made action; Examples: Anschutz, Suhl, CZ, Remington 40X, Winchester 52, etc.

No restrictions on Barrel type; tuner; Stock; Trigger; Scope

In Factory Class, you must shoot off some form of two-piece rest system with at least one sand bag on one end. You can use a sand bag on both ends if preferred. Bi-pod\_front and sandbag rear is ok.

Ammunition: .221R only manufactured in excess of one million rounds.

No jacketed bullets or hand loads in any class.

Experienced shooters will find that shooting successfully at "Rifleman distances" is a major confidence builder and an opportunity not to be missed!
