QUALIFICATIONS PROCESS FOR 600-YARD RANGE

(For Members who are not already on the qualified list or who want an access key)

If you already have a key to the 600, you're good to go. If you don't - Shooters who hold current Hi Power NRA or CMP classification cards are automatically certified – just send message to any of the "Club Mentors" list below. Shooters who are currently active in Long-range shooting matches at the club can be automatically certified by the Match Director – just have Match Director contact any one of the "Club Mentors" listed below.

<u>All others</u> will be required to undergo the following qualification process:

- STEP 1 Watch and understand videos by Ryan Cleckner. There are 12 total videos totaling 2 hours and 54 minutes. Watch all of them at: https://www.youtube.com/playlist?list=PLhRk5c1jcskxQQ46n1x6z8vI-cCo1Zixk
- STEP 2 If a club member is unsure after watching the videos and they need help before
 qualification, they may contact a <u>club mentor</u>* to schedule a time for both parties to meet at the 600yard range to get one-on-one training.
- STEP 3 Once the club member is confident and ready for qualification, they can schedule a time for the qualification process with any of the "Club Mentors" listed below.

Prior to qualifications, the applicant must have their rifles zeroed and will need up to 50 rounds of ammo, safety glasses, and ear protection. This is a requirement. A notebook with your rifle come-up data and/or ballistic calculator are also required. Additional items that shooters may bring are: a spotting scope; shooting mat; sling; shooting bags; shooting jacket and gloves

Steel IDPA targets will be used for the qualification process. They measure 24 inches tall by 18 inch wide.

The club safety rules must be emphasized every time shooting is conducted on the range:

- Always keep muzzle pointed in a safe direction. This means down range or up during transport.
- Always keep the action open and the gun unloaded until you are ready to use it.
- Always keep you finger off the trigger until the sights are on target.

To pass the qualification, hit-rates for the various distances will be:

200 yards – 3 of 5 300 yards – 3 of 5 600 yards – 2 of 5
