Henry County Gun Club will hold its first 2021 Vintage Military Open Sight Match this month. This match will be held the 3rd Saturday of each month beginning with this match.

Entry Fee: \$10-HCGC member; \$15 non-member

9am Saturday, February 20th at the 600-yard range

Match Governance:

This match will be conducted according to CMP Competition Rules and regulations available at http://www.thecmp.org/ under competitions.

Course of Fire:

Each relay will complete the course of fire before moving from the firing line. All stages will fire from 200 yards on the Short Range (SR) Competitive target.

Stage 1: Slow fire, prone, maximum of 5 sighting shots followed by 20 record shots, time limit of 25 minutes. Shooter must inform scorekeeper before starting record shots.

Stage 2 - Rapid fire, prone from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 80 seconds.

Stage 3 - Rapid fire, sitting from standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 70 seconds.

Stage 4 - Slow fire, standing, 10 record shots, time limit of 10 minutes.

Rifles Permitted:

 Any military rifle in "as issued" configuration in original caliber and using original iron sights as per <u>CMP Competition Rules and Regulations</u>.
