Highlights from the MAY Meeting

Website updates – April calendar removed, and July added. March minutes posted.

BOG-approved via email vote: Applicants John Farmer, David Cocanaugher. Derek Leslie, Chad Wagoner. \$50 donation to Henry County Rescue; \$105/mo. for privy at 100/200 range.

April Match Reports: Skeet: 62 (229 rounds); Trap: 72 (182 rounds); HighPower: 17; USPSA: 21; Steel: 9; Vintage Sniper: 24; Bullet Pro: 11; Tactical Rifle: 8; Rimfire Challenge: 13

Announcements: Both Appleseed events for this year sold out quickly, congrats to Don Duncan for heading that project up. A big "thank you" from Neal for everyone that helped on the LED light installation for the Trap & Skeet fields. Price increase for Skeet/Trap target postponed until first of next year.

Old (unfinished) Business: Front driveway patch needed. It was decided to go ahead and pave the drive. Neal to get quotes in time for the July Membership vote.

New Business: Confirmed that Safety Briefs for new members must be conducted by a BOG member. Sponsors will coordinate with new member and BOG to complete. 600-yard driveway needs grading. Electronic gate voted down with alternate plan being new combination padlocks and pushbutton door locks. Expense approved for getting new lock for the Field 1 low house. \$150 approved for pole caps for the lights for Field 1 & 2 and up to \$500 for lift rental to accomplish this. Up to \$500 approved for vegetation herbicide for Club grounds. \$2000 approved for full load of gravel for Clubhouse grounds and ½-load of rip rap for the 600-yard driveway. Brian to get quote for more Club hats and short-sleeved shirts.

New Club-member SPONSORSHIP

All Henry County Gun Club Membership applications require a **SPONSOR or BOG MEMBER** to be named as part of the application process.

The named **SPONSOR or BOG Member** is responsible for helping the new applicant understands the process. That person will make sure the new applicant records attendance of 3 Club Events and Safety Brief on the application and Safety Brief document.

These actions must be completed before the applicant will be eligible for a Probationary Vote at a MEMBERSHIP meeting which is only held <u>4 times</u> per year: **January; April; July & November.** When voted in as Probationary member, they will receive membership card and key to the front gate & Clubhouse side-door.

One year after the BOG-approval date, the Probationary Member is then automatically eligible for the SECOND Membership Vote for FULL Membership, no further action required.

If an application (with payment) comes in <u>without</u> a named sponsor, a BOG member will be designated as the applicant's Sponsor and will guide the applicant through the process.

All three documents (application, safety brief & waiver) can be printed from the website under "Join Our Club!" at <u>http://www.henrycountygunclub.com/new-membership/</u>

Also, these three documents are also available in the portable filing box that sits on the Sign-in table at the Clubhouse.
