Announcements: Thank you – goes out to Ken Donahue for fixing clubhouse water leak, Pat Friel for night-shoot lighting work, and to William Cooper for his electrical help.

Old (unfinished) Business: Driveway paving quotes still being gathered to present to Membership at the July meeting. Combo padlocks for gates and doors tabled for now. Brian to get quote for more Club hats and short-sleeved shirts.

New Business: Skeet Field 2 lighting needs some rewiring and new light fixture mounts. \$316 approved for a 36-inch portable fan. 600-yard berm needs reinforcing with new wood ties or poles on hand and the 300-yard berm needs encroaching brush removed. Inoperable soda machine to be removed. \$1950 approved to remodel both clubhouse restrooms. \$1400 approved for 4 mini-poppers for USPSA. Additional Pistol Bay construction discussed, and quotes being gathered. Getting quotes for repair/replace Skeet/Trap fencing and steps. \$150 approved for Bullet Pro 150 targets. Discussion had on how to attract younger members to the club.

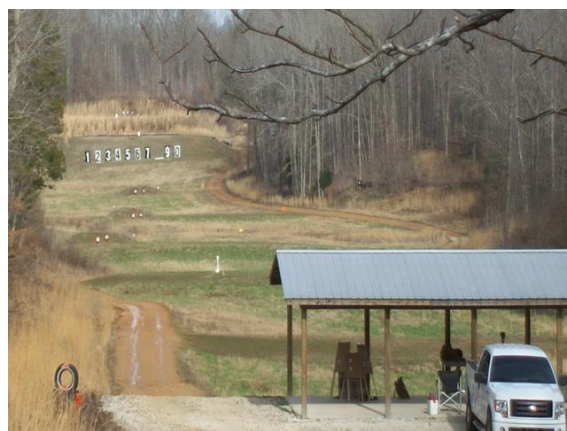

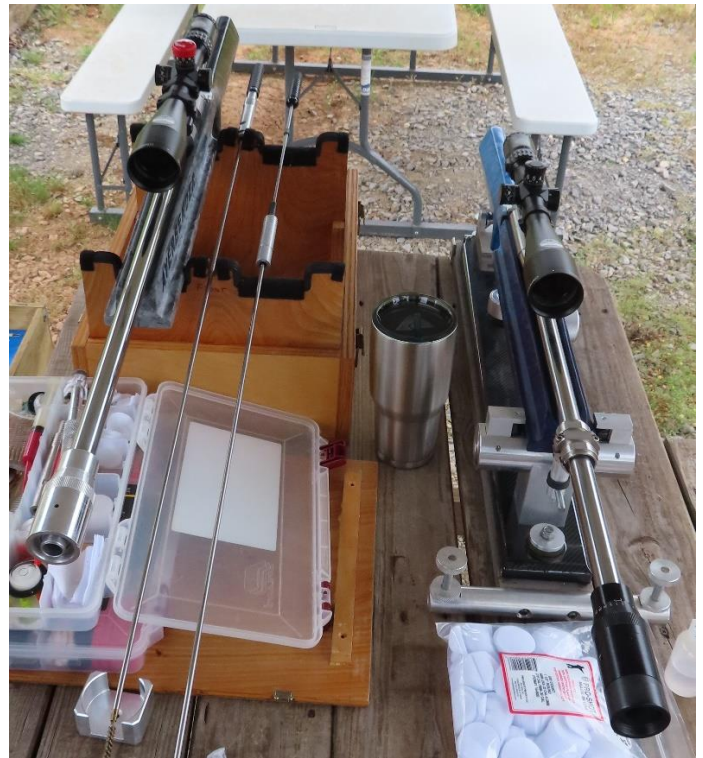
