Highlights from the December Meeting

- *Website updates November calendar removed, and February 2023 added. October minutes posted.
- *Membership: TOTALS: Total: 350 -- 312 Full Members; 32 Probationary; 5 BOG-approved.

Renewal Progress: As of today, 149 of 346 paid for 44% with 5 dropouts (192 to go). Note: 4 Prospects approved in November to be voted on in April, will pay \$100 pro-rate.

*November Match Reports: Skeet: 36 (146 rounds); Trap: 28 (129 rounds); USPSA: 10; Sport Handgun: 12.

Approval by BOG via email: Duey Payne membership application approved. \$31.80 approved for Jeff Ralls on chairs for the 50-yard. Announcements: The Club will host the Tennessee State Steel Challenge Championship March 25th. You can sign up through Practiscore beginning January 1st, 2023. Special Thanks to Pat Friel for spearheading the installation of new, lighted flagpole for the Clubhouse. One confirmed report of deer poachers shooting from their vehicles along Goldston Springs Road near Club property. Be on the lookout and report incidents to the Board. Silhouette target-berm beams to be installed early Spring.

Old (unfinished) Business:

Gathered quotes for setting up Wi-Fi for the Club grounds (including the 600) and voted to proceed with the project set for completion in early Spring at a cost of \$1000 plus \$110 per month for the service. This system will enable security cameras and Wi-Fi calling.

New Business: Ryan Anderson has offered to help us with the website and possibly streamline the dues payment process by making it online. \$2000 advance ("upfront") money approved for 50-yard bay expansion project. Discussed possible hiring of a part-time "groundskeeper" for mowing and general appearance of the Club grounds. To install front gate stops to keep the gate from swinging too far off the driveway.

SAFETY FIRST

It is recommended all club members, regardless of medical skill levels, initially and then periodically review first aid procedures. Firearms are inherently dangerous and require the utmost respect and attention to safe operating procedures. Accidents do AND WILL happen! Having a prepared mindset and skillset can and will save lives. Review of proper use of the IFAK (individual first aid kit) employed by our club can easily be accomplished with YOU TUBE videos listed below.

Everything you need in your IFAK. Sheepdog response IFAKs 101

Application of Israeli pressure bandage Skinny Medic

CAT G7 Tourniquet use/application Skinny Medic

CPR Training: Best CPR Video Ever

The IFAK used by the Club and located in pistol bay #1, the clubhouse on the West wall and at the 600-yard Rifle range is the **LX Spread Eagle Gunshot/Trauma/Hemorrhage kit**. The listed videos explain how to use the following contents.



Each kit contains:

NAR (North American Rescue) Hyfin Chest seals

NAR CAT G7 Tourniquet

Gloves (2)

Israeli Combat Pressure Bandage

Fluff gauze

Burn gel

ABD (Large Abdominal Wound Dressing)

Nasopharyngeal airway

Quick Clot Z-fold gauze to pack INTO wounds

Cutting Shears

Foil (Space Blanket) for shock and maintain body heat

2" ACE bandage roll

2", 3", & 4" Kling gauze rolls

It is recommended that ALL MEMBERS obtain and know how to use their own trauma kits to always have when using firearms. Many are available for less than \$100 and need not be as extensive as the Club's kit. Merely go to Amazon.com and query IFAK.

Remember, you must be prepared to deal with trauma. Prepare your mind!!! Create scenarios in your mind and your desired response. The life you save may be YOURS!

We need ALL our members to pitch in and help by:

Be SAFE and heed the SIGNS posted

- Use the HOT/COLD range signs
- Wear adequate hearing and eye protection
- · Keep weapons unloaded until you are on the firing line, ready to shoot
- You are REQUIRED to sign the sign in/out books when arriving/leaving
- Do not shoot steel targets with rifles or magnum pistol loads except for the 100/200 and 600-yard range
- Do not use concrete blocks, bricks, cans, bottles, etc. as targets.
- Use the SAFE AREAS to work on your weapons
- Return target stands & sticks back to their proper place

Clean up after yourself.

- Sweep your spent casings and put them in the trash or in one of the cartridge buckets.
- Take out everything you brought in, namely, trash.
- If you find trash when you arrive, clean it up before you leave.
- If the trash cans are full, empty them out in the dumpster.
- If there's something that needs fixed, report it to the BOG or Match Director.
- Volunteer for periodic Workdays.
