Treasurer's report: - Approved as read

SAFETY FIRST

It is recommended all club members, regardless of medical skill levels, initially and then periodically review first aid procedures. Firearms are inherently dangerous and require the utmost respect and attention to safe operating procedures. Accidents do AND WILL happen! Having a prepared mindset and skillset can and will save lives. Review of proper use of the IFAK (individual first aid kit) employed by our club can easily be accomplished with YOU TUBE videos listed below.

Everything you need in your IFAK. Sheepdog response IFAKs 101

Application of Israeli pressure bandage Skinny Medic

CAT G7 Tourniquet use/application Skinny Medic

CPR Training: Best CPR Video Ever

The IFAK used by the Club and located in pistol bay #1, the clubhouse on the West wall and at the 600-yard Rifle range is the **LX Spread Eagle Gunshot/Trauma/Hemorrhage kit**. The listed videos explain how to use the following contents.



Each kit contains: NAR (North American Rescue) Hyfin Chest seals NAR CAT G7 Tourniquet Gloves (2) Israeli Combat Pressure Bandage Fluff gauze Burn gel ABD (Large Abdominal Wound Dressing) Nasopharyngeal airway Quick Clot Z-fold gauze to pack INTO wounds Cutting Shears Foil (Space Blanket) for shock and maintain body heat 2", ACE bandage roll 2", 3", & 4" Kling gauze rolls

It is recommended that ALL MEMBERS obtain and know how to use their own trauma kits to always have when using firearms. Many are available for less than \$100 and need not be as extensive as the Club's kit. Merely go to Amazon.com and query IFAK.

Remember, you must be prepared to deal with trauma. Prepare your mind!!! Create scenarios in your mind and your desired response. The life you save may be YOURS!

To help us keep <u>Henry County Gun Club</u> - the best that it can be!

We need ALL our members to pitch in and help by:

Be SAFE and heed the SIGNS posted

- Use the HOT/COLD range signs
- Wear adequate hearing and eye protection
- Keep weapons unloaded until you are on the firing line, ready to shoot
- You are REQUIRED to sign the sign in/out books when arriving/leaving
- Do not shoot steel targets with rifles or magnum pistol loads except for the 100/200 and 600-yard range
- Do not use concrete blocks, bricks, cans, bottles, etc. as targets.
- Use the SAFE AREAS to work on your weapons
- Return target stands & sticks back to their proper place

Clean up after yourself.

- Sweep your spent casings and put them in the trash or in one of the cartridge buckets.
- Take out everything you brought in, namely, trash.
- If you find trash when you arrive, clean it up before you leave.
- If the trash cans are full, empty them out in the dumpster.
- If there's something that needs fixed, report it to the BOG or Match Director.
- Volunteer for periodic Workdays.

An Open Letter form Don Duncan on APPLESEED

Dear Club Members,

As some of you may remember, we had an Appleseed event at the club last May and it was sold out early. As a result, some were prevented from attending. We have another one scheduled for the third weekend in May, (20-21), in 2023. Registration for it has opened earlier this year and already 6/20 have registered. Therefore, if any are interested, they should sign up soon.

At these events we teach the fundamentals of rifle marksmanship, using a sling as a support in the field positions; prone, sitting, and standing. It is for experienced shooters as well as beginners. In fact, it is common for experienced shooters and Army veterans to fail our qualification test. They tell us that it is a humbling experience and that we teach more in one day than the Army taught them in 20 years. On the other hand, some beginners do pass our test. In fact, the newest Army Marksmanship Manual was written by a previous Appleseed instructor who praises Appleseed highly.

To register for the event, go to the Appleseed website: appleseedinfo.org. Under "Events" click on Find an Event, then TN. Find the May Puryear event for registration and information. Also, under "Events" again, read, at least, How to Prepare, and Know How to Shoot. The registration fee in this manner is \$75. However, clicking in the middle of our home page will give information on a Gift Certificate which will cost only \$48.75 until January 1. It may take a couple of weeks for the Gift Certificate to arrive by mail, and instructions will be given on how to use it for an event.

We will also be having a Known Distance Appleseed event on the 600 yard range on September 16-17. But you need to have attended a regular Appleseed event before coming to this one. And last year the September event was sold out in April.
