Old (unfinished) Business:

Gathered quotes for setting up Wi-Fi for the Club grounds (including the 600) and voted to proceed with the project set for completion in early Spring at a cost of \$1000 plus \$110 per month for the service. This system will enable security cameras and Wi-Fi calling.

New Business:

Ryan Anderson has offered to help us with the website and possibly streamlining the dues payment process by making it online. \$2000 advance ("upfront") money approved for 50-yard bay expansion project. Discussed possible hiring of a part-time "groundskeeper" for mowing and general appearance of the Club grounds. To install front gate stops to keep the gate from swinging too far off the driveway.
