Highlights from the February Meeting

*Membership: TOTALS: Total: 308 -- 276 Full Members; 24 Probationary; 8 BOG-approved.

Renewal Status: 87% renewal rate with 45 members leaving.

Of the 45 members not renewing, 11 of these resigned with cause.

The remaining 34 were removed from the Master for no response.

Approval by BOG via email: \$60 approved for Alan Crowley on dues/membership postage. \$300 to Thomas Cannon for welding & fuel to complete the Silhouette setup at the 100/200.

\$500 approved on targets and supplies for NRA HighPower.

Announcements: Grant Laird will host a Steel Challenge Championship match on March 25th and a USPSA Championship match on August 25th.

Old (unfinished) Business: TJ & Kyle to push back tree line on the southwest side of the 600-yard range and still take the old Skeet high-house taken to 600-yard for new shooting position and antenna for Wi-Fi.

New Business: Discussed replacing gate keys (front gate & 600-yd) with 4-digit combination padlocks and installing keypad lock for Clubhouse door. Discussed roll-out of Wi-Fi info and extending coverage to the 100 & 600-yard ranges. Discussed using online payment for next year's dues drive and possibly moving the collection drive in March, mor details to follow. \$1500 advance approved for Todd on the 50-yd construction project. Thomas Cannon to get quote on enlarging the shooting platform at the 100/200-yd range. Member suggested spraying the ground for ticks, will gather info and get quote. Suggested awareness campaign to stop members from shooting metal targets with armor-piercing rounds. Three new member-prospects approved by BOG as Temporary Members to include: Shane Joyner, Keith Riley, and Ted Leach.

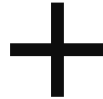

Announcements

Stage 1 of our **Wi-Fi** set up is complete.



We now have Wi-Fi service in and around the Clubhouse. Members with smart-phones or laptops will be able to access the internet and use their wi-fi calling function for phone calls and ballistic apps. Ballistics apps will be able to pull real-time atmospheric data, BC databases and other information to better calculate firing solutions in the field.

The next stage will be adding wi-fi signal repeater/booster units to expand the coverage all the way to the 100-yard range. There will also be cameras mounted on the apex of the Clubhouse and on the light pole for the driveway entrance.

The final step will be to extend the coverage out to the 600-yard range.

To access Wi-Fi at the clubhouse, choose the 2.4G network for longer range, or the 5G for faster download. The password is written in the upper left corner of the chalk/blackboard in the Clubhouse.

The 2.4G network has a 100 Mbps upload and download speed. The 5G downloads at 325 Mbps and uploads at 375 Mbps.
