We have all seen examples of this vandalism in our Club.

Vandalism is not just a nuisance; it is also costly and dangerous.



This is a prop used in various matches at the club. Someone has laid this down and used it as a target. This is willful destruction of club property. There ARE plenty of target stands and sticks available.



Targets at the 100-yd & Pistol bays that have been fired upon with high-velocity rifle, magnum pistol or even armor-piercing rounds. These metal plates are permanently placed for the convenience of members. They aren't cheap.

A lot of work has gone into the building and maintenance of HCGC, one of the finest clubs in the surrounding area, if not the state. Whoever did this and/or similar acts at the club do not deserve to be a member.

Anyone caught trespassing, hunting, poaching or vandalizing Club property will be recommended for membership termination.

We will soon have security cameras in place that will help identify any culprits. Meanwhile, any Club member that witnesses any such action should notify a BOG member immediately.

DO NOT attempt to approach a suspected vandal. If possible, get a picture of their vehicle license plate and report to any BOG member.

Announcements

Stage 1 of our **Wi-Fi** set up is complete.



We now have Wi-Fi service in and around the Clubhouse. Members with smart-phones or laptops will be able to access the internet and use their wi-fi calling function for phone calls and ballistic apps. Ballistics apps will be able to pull real-time atmospheric data, BC databases and other information to better calculate firing solutions in the field.

<u>The next stage</u> will be adding wi-fi signal repeater/booster units to expand the coverage all the way to the 100-yard range. There will also be cameras mounted on the apex of the Clubhouse and on the light pole for the driveway entrance.

<u>The final step</u> will be to extend the coverage out to the 600-yard range.

To access Wi-Fi at the clubhouse, choose the 2.4G network for longer range, or the 5G for faster download. <u>The password is written in the upper left corner of the chalk/blackboard in the Clubhouse.</u>

The 2.4G network has a 100 Mbps upload and download speed. The 5G downloads at 325 Mbps and uploads at 375 Mbps.
