Treasurer's report – approved as read.

Secretary's report: January Minutes – approved as read.

Discussed roll-out of Wi-Fi info and extending coverage to the 100 & 600-yard ranges. Discussed using online payment for next year's dues drive and possibly moving the collection drive in March, mor details to follow. \$1500 advance approved for Todd on the 50-yd construction project. Thomas Cannon to get quote on enlarging the shooting platform at the 100/200-yd range. Member suggested spraying the ground for ticks, will gather info and get quote. Suggested awareness campaign to stop members from shooting metal targets with armor-piercing rounds.
