Grant Laird to get quote to build a shelter in the "Fort". New ceiling lights being installed in Clubhouse. 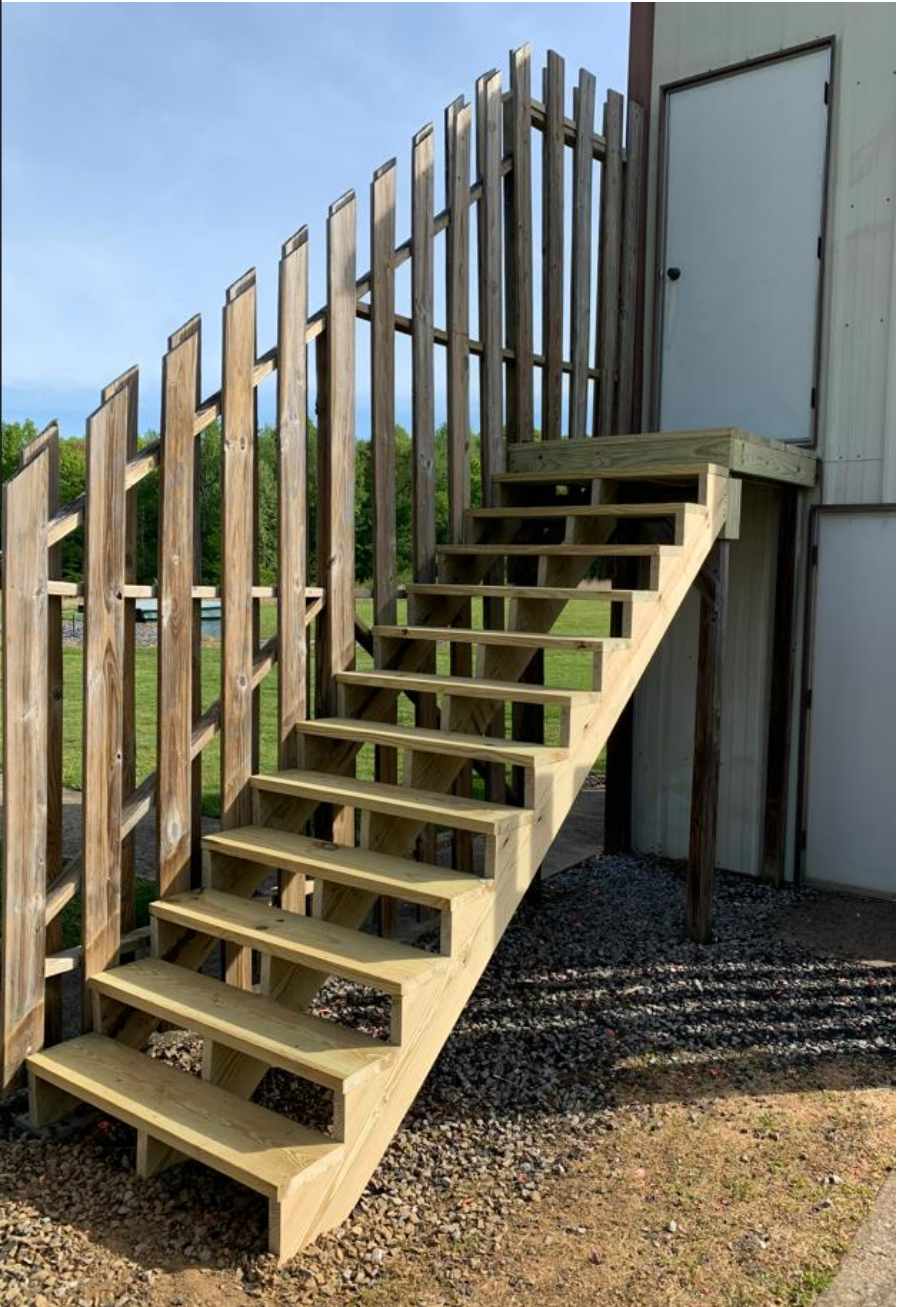
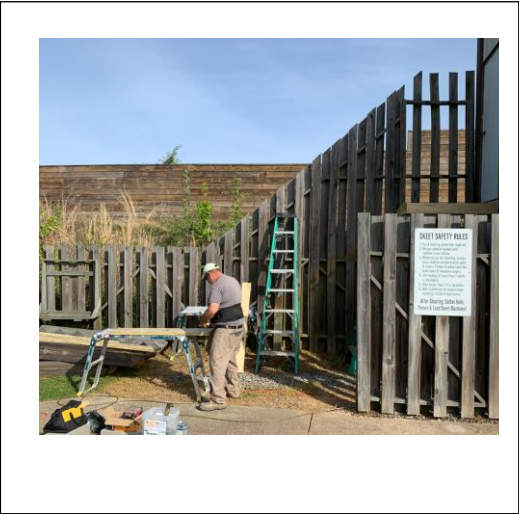

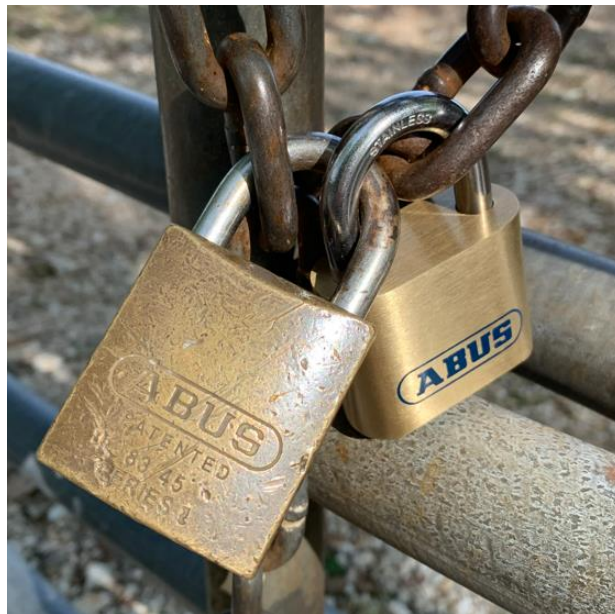

Skeet High House getting new stairs and deck installed...



Announcements

New combination locks on gates and Clubhouse have been installed.



For now, BOTH the old and new locks will be on the gate so you can get in by unlocking EITHER one of the locks. You can use your old key, or the new combo lock.

NOTE: Be sure so lock gate back as pictured above by interlocking the 2 padlocks, attach one chain end to the first lock and the other chain end to the second lock

THIS WEEKEND the old lock will be completely removed, and you will only gain entry by using the combo lock.

TIPS on using the new combo padlocks:

1. Dial in the combination located at the bottom of the lock.
2. Push DOWN on the shackle/shank towards the padlock body to open.
3. As soon as you unlock the combo, immediately spin at least one of the numbers before leaving the lock hanging open on the open gate.
4. Spinning at least one of the numbers will hide the real combination from the next person and will also enable you to lock it back. The lock will not re-lock without spinning the numbers.

The 4-digit combination for the front gate, clubhouse and storage sheds was sent to you via email message. A separate message was sent to 600-yard key holders. The 600-yard has a different combination.
