2023 HCGC VINTAGE AND MODERN MILITARY SNIPER WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP

Modern and Vintage will be on the line for both matches. We have room for 18 teams on the line for each match and it will be first come first on the line. Each team can shoot each match in the same class or swap classes.

MODERN Class is geared towards the Post Korean War to pre-magnum military sniper rifles (Zfk-55, L42A1, M40 series, M24 series, Vz 54, M21, M110, Dragunov, L96, Mk12, etc).

VINTAGE Class includes M1941 Springfield, M70 with Unertl, M1903A4, M41, M1891/30 PU, PE or PEM, M1 Garand family of snipers, Swede M41 series, German K98 family of snipers, K43, T38 or T99 snipers, No4T, etc. Rifles such as the ZFK, PSL, M76, Dragunov, and L42A1 may fire in either class.

You will shoot as a team; spotter scores the hit or miss. Front bag or bipod allowed, no rear bags or rear support. Both Classes will be won by the combined score of the two team members.

The Course of Fire includes the following stages:

1. The Gauntlet – 5 targets at 100-200-300-400-500
2. Long Range – From 600 to 850 yards
3. Rapid Fire – 25-seconds timer – 100 to 400 yards
4. Mystery Event 600 Yards for Modern & 450 for Vintage
5. Know your Limits – Modern 300-350 yards; Vintage 150 to 250 yards

ROAD CONSTRUCTION still affecting travel to the Club FROM THE NORTH.

The “north” entrance to get to Goldston Springs off of Hwy 140 is still CLOSED. Take one of these 2 alternated routes from Hwy 641-South:

1. Go 1 block past Hwy 140 and right at the traffic light at Laird's BBQ. Go 200 yards, cross RR tracks and left on McDonald which becomes Foundry Hill and follow to Goldston Springs Road by bearing right.
2. Go through Puryear, down the hill and right on Parkhill Road, go 1.2 miles and turn left on Goldston Springs Road.

Notice will be sent as soon as the construction is complete, and the road is re-opened.
