## Henry County Gun Club New Member Safety & Facility Briefing Checklist RULES and REGULATIONS

All Board of Governor members are available and able to conduct this checklist Trainer: Review each item with new member. Check the box when completed.

General Firearm Safety
☐ <u>Always</u> keep the muzzle pointed in a safe direction; never point a firearm at
anyone or anything you do not want to shoot.
☐ <u>Always</u> keep your finger off the trigger and outside the trigger guard until
you are ready to shoot.
Always keep the action open and the gun unloaded until you are ready
to use it.
☐ All firearms brought onto club property must be bagged or in a case,
they are to be unloaded, no magazine inserted and no ammunition in the
chamber of semi-automatics, empty chambers in the cylinders of revolvers.
The only exception will be for persons with concealed carry permits, in
which case handguns shall remain securely holstered.
☐ <b>Be considerate</b> of others using the range at all times. Do not remove firearms from bags and cases until you can do so safely, without "sweeping"
anyone with the muzzle.

Additional Safety rules
☐ Firearms are to be <u>unloaded</u> when not actually in use.
□ <b>Don't rely</b> on your gun's safety.
☐ Be sure of your target and what is beyond it.
☐ Use proper ammunition.
☐ If your gun fails to fire when trigger is pulled, handle with care.
☐ <u>Always</u> wear eye and ear protection when shooting.
☐ Be sure the barrel is clear of obstructions before shooting.
☐ Learn the mechanical and handling characteristics of the
firearm you are using.
