ROAD CONSTRUCTION <u>still</u> affecting travel to the Club FROM THE NORTH. Projected to be completed May-June 2024

The "north" entrance to get to Goldston Springs off of Hwy 140 is still CLOSED. Take one of these 2 alternated routes <u>from Hwy 641-South</u>:

- 1. <u>Go 1 block past Hwy 140</u> and right at the traffic light at Laird's BBQ. Go 200 yards, cross RR tracks and left on McDonald which becomes Foundry Hill and follow to Goldston Springs Road by bearing right.
- 2. Go <u>through Puryear</u>, down the hill and right on Parkhill Road, go 1.2 miles and turn left on Goldston Springs Road.

Notice will be sent as soon as the construction is complete, and the road is re-opened.
